

TFHAR Youth Scholarships

Scholarship Rules and Procedures

1. Academic (\$1,000 total) scholarships are available to graduates of Phillips County high schools.
2. Spiritual/Personal Development (\$4,000 total) scholarships are available to Phillips County high school students and graduates.
3. All decisions are made by TFHAR Scholarship Board members. THFAR staff members do not have any say in which students receive scholarships.
4. TFHAR interns, if a Phillips County graduate, are eligible for scholarships.
5. Students may **not** receive BOTH an academic and SPD scholarship in the same calendar year. (E.g., students who receive SPD scholarships in 2014 may receive an academic scholarship in 2015.)
6. Upon notification of scholarship, the student must reply within two weeks to accept scholarship and provide necessary information for board to administer funds. If the student does not respond within two weeks (14 days), the funds will then be awarded to the next top applicant.
7. If all monies are not distributed for the calendar year, the money will roll over to the following calendar year for additional scholarships.

Academic Scholarship Procedures

1. The TFHAR Scholarship Board will provide up to \$1,000 of academic scholarships for the academic year (fall to spring semesters). This money will be distributed in one of two ways:
 - a. One \$1,000 scholarship distributed to one student in the fall semester
 - OR—
 - b. Two \$500 scholarships distributed to two students in the fall semester.
2. After receiving an academic scholarship once, student cannot reapply.
3. Academic scholarships will be paid directly to the institution, **not to the recipient**.
4. This money can be used toward books or other on-campus expenses, again, paid directly to the institution.
5. The board will notify TFHAR of scholarship recipient and TFHAR will administer funds.

Spiritual/Personal Development Scholarship Procedures

1. The TFHAR Scholarship Board will provide up to \$4,000 of SPD scholarships for the calendar year.
2. Requests must be made in May and November.
3. Scholarships will be awarded in June and December.
4. This money will be distributed to an indefinite number of students.
5. The smallest scholarship awarded will be \$250, the largest \$1,000.
6. After receiving a SPD scholarship once, students can reapply.
7. SPD scholarships will be paid directly to the institution, camp, organization, not to the recipient.
8. This money can be used toward other SPD expenses under the administration of TFHAR.
9. The board will notify TFHAR of scholarship recipient and TFHAR will administer funds.
